We call upon your Government to withdraw all anti-union laws, starting with Decree 35 of 2011 on Essential National Industries (Employment), as it clearly contravenes the ILO Conventions ratified by your country by restricting trade union activity. We also demand the withdrawal of the case against Mr. Daniel Urai, President of the Fiji Trades Union Congress on charges of unlawful assembly.

We urge you to ensure that the people of Fiji are allowed to exercise their democratic rights to freedom of assembly and freedom of association without interference from the State.
